

Avoid Crowdedness to Enjoy a Nice and Safe Mt. Fuji Climbing!

Too many climbers may spoil your fun. So, avoid crowded days and hours to experience Mt. Fuji to the fullest. Despite many climbers every year, the mountain is open only for around two months, and no wonder it's easily crowded. Especially, near-summit paths just before the sunrise always flood with people.



Avoid crowded days

Mt. Fuji opens in early July, and climbers start to increase shortly after the rainy season ends – in later July. As shown in the calendar, weekends, holidays and Bon festival days in August are very crowded. On days marked “Extremely crowded” in the calendar, mountain huts are overcrowded, and congestion on near-summit paths at sunrise hours can almost immobilize the climbers. So, it’s advisable to plan your journey on weekdays, which allows you to use facilities more comfortably and more importantly, enjoy safe walking at your pace.
